## Good afternoon.

Two articles were posted late this morning that we wanted to alert you about:

1: The Detroit Free Press contacted the University late yesterday to advise that they planned to run a story on the Corvias Housing project posted on the Budget & Finance Committee agenda. They gathered information for the story from the materials provided on the Board's website. The University declined comment on the story until after the Board has made a decision. 2. The Muckraker has run a story today regarding a poster in the Tierney House that featured a photograph of Steve Neavling (the blog's author) and the words: "Dangerous - do not let in building. Call Chief Holt immediately (number)." Someone who saw the poster sent a picture to Mr. Neavling. The poster was placed in Tierney by Mrs. Wilson, whose office is in that building. She felt personally threatened after Mr. Neavling showed up unannounced at the Jacob House last week in an attempt to speak directly to the president. While the President felt this was an overreaction, it was in response to what could be perceived as invasion into a private space. Mr. Neavling is now texting Mrs. Wilson directly on her mobile phone. The University urged Mr. Neavling to resist posting the Chief's cell phone number in the story.
